

**HUDSON
SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT**

**February 3, 2007
The State of New Hampshire**

To the inhabitants of the School District of Hudson, New Hampshire qualified to vote in district affairs; you are hereby notified to meet in the Community Center in said district on the 3rd day of February, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. for the first session of the annual school district meeting, to deliberate on the following subjects and to meet again at the Community Center in said district on Tuesday, March 13, 2007 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for the second session of the annual school district meeting to vote by official ballot upon the following subjects:

Warrant Article 1:

Shall the Hudson School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$39,948,672? Should this article be defeated, the operating budget shall be \$39,328,434, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments, required by previous action of the Hudson School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13 X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Warrant Article 2:

Shall the Hudson School District vote to authorize the School Board to enter into a 10-year lease/purchase agreement in the amount of \$2,743,996 at 4.1% interest, with the first payment to begin in the fiscal year 2008-09, for the purpose of completing an energy retrofit of District schools and further authorize the School Board to apply for, accept and expend state building aid, utility rebates and any other government or private funding for this purpose, which revenues together with reduced energy costs from the projected energy savings is projected to entirely offset the costs of this project. The lease agreement will contain an "escape" clause.

Warrant Article 3:

Shall the Hudson School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25,000 for the purpose of providing an after school tutorial academic assistance program for struggling students in Hudson Memorial School?

Warrant Article 4:

Shall the Hudson School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$38,691, which includes salary and benefit changes for the non-bargaining staff members of the Hudson School District? This represents a 4.5% performance salary pool for the non-bargaining staff which includes the SAU Central Office Staff and Computer Technicians.
